Bill Tiberio holds degrees in Music Education from Ithaca College and SUNY Fredonia and is an instrumental music teacher at Fairport High School where he conducts a concert band, sophomore band, two jazz ensembles, pit orchestra for musicals and several chamber woodwind ensembles. He also teaches woodwind lessons for students in grades 6-12 in the Fairport School District. He holds a summer position with the Eastman Community Music School where he conducts the high school summer jazz ensembles. Bill is the past President of the New York State Chapter of the International Association of Jazz Educators and is an instructor in the IAJE Training Institute for jazz educators. He has also guest conducted honor concert bands and jazz ensembles throughout New York State and has served as clinician for the Eastman School JazzFest.

Bill is the conductor and founder of the Eastman Community School Chamber Winds and the Eastman Community School Junior High School Band, and he conducts the University of Rochester Wind Symphony and the University of Rochester Jazz Ensemble. He is also active as an All-State woodwind adjudicator and judges area band pageants each Spring. Bill is active as a professional woodwind player in the Rochester area and performs with the Bill Welch Band and The Bill Tiberio Band which recently played in the Rochester International Jazz Festival.
