He earned his Bachelor of Music degree in Violin & Music Education from the University of Northern Iowa and Master of Music Degree from the Eastman School of Music where he is currently completing the Doctorate of Philosophy in Music Education. He has extensive experience as a violin instructor, chamber music coach, chamber orchestra director, and orchestra conductor. During the school year at Hochstein, Mr. Fetter conducts Philharmonia (a full orchestra) and Sinfonia (a string orchestra). He has taught in public schools and performed regularly as a violinist with a number of regional orchestras. Mr. Fetter joined the Hochstein faculty in 2002.
