Hochstein Youth Symphony Orchestra and Rochester Philharmonic Youth Orchestra Join Forces for Joint Summer Pops Concert

Free concert on Sunday, August 20 at Hochstein Performance Hall

ROCHESTER, N.Y.— Young musicians from the **Hochstein Youth Symphony Orchestra (HYSO)** and **Rochester Philharmonic Youth Orchestra (RPYO)**, join forces for a joint concert of Pops music this summer. These two fine youth orchestras will perform music from Broadway musicals, blockbuster movies, and operas, including selections from Rogers & Hammerstein's *Carousel, Star Wars, Pirates of the Caribbean, Bizet's Carmen,* and Verdi's *Nabucco*, among others. **Paul Shewan** conducts the joint orchestras, with vocal soloist **Amanda Meldrum** singing Ella Fitzgerald's breakthrough hit "A-Tisket, A-Tasket," to celebrate Ella's 100th birthday. This free concert is on **Sunday, August 20 at 3:00 pm** in the Hochstein Performance Hall.

Paul Shewan is Professor of Conducting and Trumpet at Roberts Wesleyan College, where he conducts the Wind Ensemble and the Orchestra, and teaches trumpet, brass ensembles, and instrumental conducting. A graduate of the Eastman School of Music he is a member of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra trumpet section and is a frequent RPO guest conductor.

Amanda Meldrum: Amanda holds a Bachelor of Science in Music Therapy from SUNY Fredonia, has studied Vocal Performance and Music Education at Eastman School of Music, and is currently completing a master's in Creative Arts Therapy at Nazareth College. She brings experience as a board-certified music therapist, rehabilitation therapist, private voice instructor, and youth community musical theatre director. At Allendale Columbia, Amanda manages and directs the Upper School musicals and plays, teaches Upper School theatre classes, leads the Boys Ensemble, and teaches Middle School music electives and Drama Foundations.
